Spring 1 2026 – Climate and weather

As Writers we will be learning the persuasive talk for writing text, 'Fantastic fish for sale'. We will learn features of persuasive writing and how to appeal to our audience. We will also look at the finding tale, 'The Magic Faraway Tree' and write our own finding tale.

As Readers we will be working on author's language and how it is selected on purpose. We will continue to work on our retrieval and inference skills.

As Mathematicians in year 3 we will develop our understanding of multiplication and division, measure and calculate length and perimeter, explore fractions, and solve problems involving mass and capacity.

As mathematicians in year 4 we will build secure multiplication and division skills, measure and calculate length and perimeter, develop our understanding of fractions, and explore decimals including tenths and hundredths.

As Scientists we will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

As Geographers we will explore the difference between weather and climate, locate and describe the world's climate zones, identify and compare biomes and vegetation belts, and use maps, data and geographical vocabulary to understand how climate affects people, animals and environments.

In PE we will be looking at how to keep ourselves fit and learning the skills of dodgeball.

In RE we will be exploring what it means to be Hindu in Britain today.

As learners in PSHE we will explore and understand our emotions, including anger, worry and anxiety, learn strategies to manage strong feelings, develop gratitude and resilience, and begin to understand mental health topics such as depression, body image and how to seek help when needed.

In computing we will be looking at branching databases and celebrating internet safety day.
