- To work **independently** towards making a moving vehicle, recovering when things go wrong.

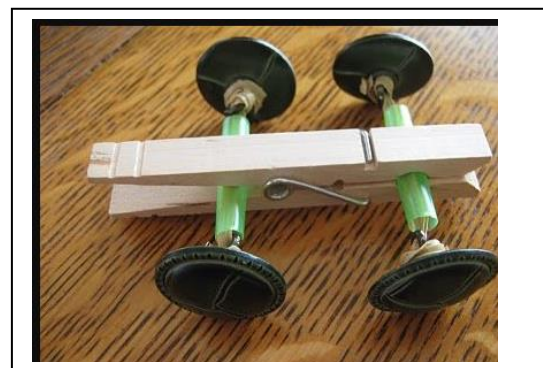
