Curriculum

There are seven key areas of learning within the EYF5 Curriculum. Below is a brief overview of the learning we will be engaging with:

Communication and Language:

We will be working on developing our functional language such as asking for things we want and answering questions using which communication method works best for us. Also developing our functional understanding of language and following simple instructions.

We will learn and continue to practice Makaton signing to aid our communication skills.

We will continue to develop our listening skills through everyday activities and games.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

We will be working on developing relationships with our peers and the adults that are supporting us in Class 6.

We will be developing the confidence to join in with new activities and engage with others.

We will be choosing the activities that we would like to engage with and making simple choices throughout the day.

In our learning we will be talking about keeping clean and healthy.

Physical Development:

We will be developing our gross motor skills through large movements such as riding bikes, climbing, throwing, digging building and balancing.

We will be developing our fine motor skills through exploring different types of media such as paint, playdoh, pens and pencils.

We will also continue to develop our self help skills working towards becoming independent when doing everyday activities such as putting our coat on, washing our hands and getting what we need.

Literacy:

We will learn new songs, rhymes and accompany them with actions and gestures. We will share stories each day and engage in role play related to stories.

We will develop our mark making skills and ascribing meaning to what we write.

Mathematics:

We will take part in finger rhymes with numbers and develop an awareness of counting and number. We will complete puzzles and develop our problem solving skills. We are going to be measuring ourselves and using language such as big and small. We will also create using shapes and pattern.

Understanding the World:

We will be developing our awareness of our environment in Class 6 and also the wider school. We are going to be sharing information about ourselves and our families. Looking at photographs of where we live and the different homes that people and animals have. We will learn about how we have grown since we were a baby and talk about the things that we needed as a baby and what we need now.

Expressive Arts and Design:

We will start to make marks intentionally and explore a variety of different media to make marks and sensorily. We will join in with our favourite songs and learn new ones.
